BACKGROUND


A survey was conducted over a five-week duration, spanning from June to July. This survey aimed to systematically gather insights and opinions from a diverse respondent pool. The survey amassed a total of 228 responses.

Claire Pritchard had written the questions before we published the survey. Most questions had a few free box so findings have been grouped/summarised below.

Question 1 - Are you aware or have you heard about the SEND local offer/website? If yes, where did you hear about it? (192 responses)






Question 2 - If you have looked at or used the local offer website, what did you think of it? (209 Responses)

I really dislike the picture in the Facebook page with the masks. I find it quite triggering so have unfollowed it Couldn't see how to apply for a EHCP, or what happens when applying. Couldn't see how to get a referral for ASD assessment

Not a easy to use website. The link I clicked on didn't work.

How do you access Jigsaw as my friend needs to access it, but I cant remember which professional helped us.

Struggle to find the info, seem to have to click a lot of buttons to find what I need, could be more streamlined

The offer itself needs reviewing & improving

Respite/ short breaks restricted to under 19's. We have nothing

A couple of bits I looked up are wrong

Needs improving and then communicating to parents.

Info quoted a bit out of date. Asperger no longer diagnostic term, NAS findings from 2007, Autism Hampshire directory from 2019. Need more consistency throughout website as SEND and SEN both used - keeping to just SEND would be better

There were some other specifc issues which have been raised seperately to the LA.
